

Mulguri Waterfalls | Private Adventure Tour

Mulguri is considered a natural paradise for those seeking harmony with nature in a location that has an astounding beauty working far from the noise and hustle bustle of the city.

A very experienced and certified ICT bilingual nature guide will navigate you through the astounding jungle of Costa Rica. The one hour trip from Manuel Antonio passes through small local villages, natural springs, rain forest and then into the remote back country known as Quebrada de Arrollo.

Your first stop is at a beautiful pavilion where you can freshen up while enjoying tropical fruits and a cold beverage. The experience then continues with a trail hike to explore and discover the pristine waterfalls and natural pools. An exhilarating experience crossing a suspension bridge, with the full view of the mountain awaits before getting to the waterfalls which resembles a natural hot tub with various depths. There are a total of three waterfalls, one water drop and four natural swimming pools.

After cooling off, the tour continues with a visit to a self-sustaining farm where you will be served a delicious traditional Costa Rican wood stove lunch on the patio. The property is surrounded by mountains with green leafy forests and located at the foot of the mountain.


