

### 🕺 Marino Ballena Park | Private Hiking Tour

Ballena National Marine Park located in Bahia Ballena, Uvita is home to one of the most biologically diverse marine habitats in Costa Rica and one of the best places in the world for whale watching. From mid-July to the end of October is the best time to observe the majestic Humpback whales as they migrate from Antarctica to Marino Ballena National Park in Costa Rica to breed and raise their calves.

From late December to late February Humpback whales pass by Costa Rica as they migrate from the California and Washington state area. On a lucky day you can listen to the love songs of the whales and feel the great sensation of watching a mammal that weighs over 40 tons jump out of the water and splash the surface with its gigantic tail.
